Soil4Climate provides technical and financial assistance to practitioner organizations and young scholars seeking to improve on or monitor the impacts of soil carbon enhancing land management parctices. In Africa we provided GPS mapping service and funds for soil carbon testing.

Soil4Climate, a U.S.-based nongovernmental organization, advocates for regenerative cropping and grazing practices to improve soil fertility, increase the bionutrient density of food, restore wildlife habitat, prevent flooding, return flow to dried-up rivers, and revitalize pastoral communities while sequestering atmospheric carbon.
